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INTRODUCTION

The Right to Information Act, 2005 has put in place a practical regime to ensure the right to information for citizens by securing access to information under the control of public authorities. An informed citizenry with access to information is vital to the functioning of democracy, to contain corruption and to hold the Governments and their instrumentalities accountable. The Act seeks to promote transparency and accountability in the working of public authorities. It provides the framework for citizens to access information which is held by or under the control of any public authority which includes the right to inspection of work, documents and records. The Act applies to all public authorities including bodies owned, controlled or substantially financed by Government as well as non-Government organisations substantially financed by Government.

Under the Right to Information Act, a Central Information Commission and State Information Commissions have been set up. The Commissions receive and inquire into complaints relating to denial of information by the public authorities and decides on second appeals against the public authorities. The Commissions are also vested with powers to impose penalty on Public Information Officers found guilty under the provisions of the Act, to recommend disciplinary action against them and to require public authorities to compensate complainants for any loss or detriment suffered. The Commissions can also direct public authorities to take appropriate steps to secure compliance with the provisions of the Act.

CHAPTER - 1

WEST BENGAL INFORMATION COMMISSION

West Bengal Information Commission was constituted by the Government of West Bengal vide Notification No. 747–PAR(AR) dated 12.12.2005 which was published in The Kolkata Gazette. The Commission was reconstituted vide Notification No. 744–PAR(AR) dated 03.08.2010.

Shri Arun Kumar Bhattacharya assumed the office of State Chief Information Commissioner on 27th December, 2005 and continued upto 5th August, 2010.

Shri Sujit Kumar Sarkar joined as State Information Commissioner on 3rd December, 2009. He assumed the office of State Chief Information Commissioner on 1st December, 2010 and continued up to 6th June, 2014.

Shri K. John Koshy assumed the office of State Information Commissioner on 1st December, 2010. He assumed additional charge of the office of the State Chief Information Commissioner on 18.06.2014 and assumed the charge of the office of State Chief Information Commissioner on 03.02.2015 (A.N.) and continued upto 06.11.2015.

Dr. G.D. Gautama joined as State Information Commissioner on 5th April, 2012. He assumed the additional charge of State Chief Information Commissioner on 17.11.2015 (A.N.).

Suo Motu Information u/s 4(1) (b)

The Right to Information Act has envisaged that all the Public Authorities shall make a constant endeavour to take steps in accordance with the requirements of this Act to publish all relevant information for the knowledge of citizens at large and update the same at regular intervals.

The Act enjoins that all the records of the Public Authority should be duly catalogued and indexed in a manner and in the form which facilitates the right to information of citizens. For this purpose, the records are needed to be computerized within a reasonable time and connected through a network all over the country so that access to such records is facilitated.

Section 4(1)(b) has given a list of seventeen such vital information pertaining to each Public Authority which are to be published suo motu so that the public have minimum resort to the use of this Act to obtain information.

Functions: West Bengal Information Commission has been constituted under sub-section (1) and sub-section (7) of section 15 of the Right to Information (RTI) Act, 2005 vide a gazette notification No.747-PAR(AR) dated 12.12.2005 and published in the Gazette on 03.01.2006. The Commission's mandate is to exercise the powers conferred on, and to perform the functions assigned to it under the Act.

The general superintendence, direction and management of the affairs of the State Information Commission vests in the State Chief Information Commissioner who shall be assisted by the State Information Commissioner and exercise all such powers and does all such acts and things which may be exercised or done by the Information Commission autonomously without being subjected to directions by any other authority under the RTI Act.

The Act enjoins upon the State Government to provide the State Chief Information Commissioner and the State Information Commissioner with such officers and employees as may be necessary for the efficient performance of their functions under this Act, and the salaries and allowances payable to and the

terms and conditions of service of the officers and other employees appointed for the purpose of this Act shall be such as may be prescribed. So far thirty (30) posts of different categories have been sanctioned by the Government. A list of posts filled is as under:-

Mission – Ensure the citizens their Right to Information from public authorities in accordance with provisions of the Right to Information Act, 2005.

Vision – Transparent functioning of public authorities to enable in achieving the goals envisaged in the Constitution of India for every Indian citizen.

Objectives - Fulfilling the mandate assigned in the RTI Act, 2005.

Details of Services provided/Duties – As per the RTI Act, 2005 the Commission has been assigned the task of receiving complaints and appeals, for providing suitable relief to the appellants as per the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005.

Details of remuneration of officers and employees:

According to the provisions of section 16 (5) of the RTI Act, 2005 the salaries and allowances payable to and other terms and conditions of services of—

- (a) The State Chief Information Commissioner shall be the same as that of the Election Commissioner;
- (b) The State Information Commissioner shall be the same as that of the Chief Secretary of the State Government :

Provided that if the State Chief Information Commissioner or an Information Commissioner, at the time of his appointment is, in receipt of a pension, other than a disability or wound pension, in respect of any previous service under the Government of India or under the Government of a State, his salary in respect of the service as the Chief Information Commissioner or as an Information Commissioner shall be reduced by the amount of that pension including any portion of pension which was commuted and pension equivalent of other forms of retirement benefit excluding pension equivalent of retirement gratuity:

Provided further that if the State Chief Information Commissioner or an Information Commissioner if, at the time of his appointment is, in receipt of retirement benefits in respect of any previous service

rendered in a Corporation established by or under any Central Act or State Act or a Government company owned or controlled by the Central Government or the State Government, his salary in respect of the service as the Chief Information Commissioner or an Information Commissioner shall be reduced by the amount of pension equivalent to retirement benefits:

Provided also that the salaries, allowances and other conditions of service of the State Chief Information Commissioner and the Information Commissioners shall not be varied to their advantage after their appointment.

It has also been laid down under section 16(6) of the RTI Act, 2005 that the state Government shall provide the State Chief Information Commissioner and the State Information Commissioner with such officers and employees as may be necessary for the efficient performance of their functions under this Act, and the salaries and allowances payable to and the terms and conditions of service of the officers and other employees appointed for the purpose of this Act shall be such as may be prescribed.

CHAPTER - 2

ANNUAL REPORT for 2015

Section 25(1) of the RTI Act enjoins that the State Information Commission shall, as soon as practicable after the end of each year, prepare a report on the implementation of the provisions of the Act during that year and forward a copy to the State Government.

Section 25(2) of the RTI Act, 2005 stipulates that each department shall, in relation to the Public Authorities within their jurisdiction, collect and provide such information to the State Information Commission as is required to prepare the report under this section and comply with the requirements concerning the furnishing of that information and keeping of records for the purposes of this section.

Section 25(3) stipulates that the report shall provide the following information: Each report shall state in respect of the year to which the report relates.—

- (a) the number of requests made to each public authority;
- (b) the number of decisions where applicants were not entitled to access to the documents pursuant to the requests, the provisions of this Act under which these decisions were made and the number of times such provisions were invoked;
- (c) the number of appeals referred to the Central Information Commission or State Information Commission, as the case may be, for review, the nature of the appeals and the outcome of the appeals;
- (d) particulars of any disciplinary action taken against any officer in respect of the administration of this Act;
- (e) the amount of charges collected by each public authority under this Act;
- (f) any facts which indicate and effort by the public authorities to administer and implement the spirit and intention of this Act;
- (g) recommendations for reform, including recommendations in respect of the particular public authorities, for the development, improvement, modernization, reform or amendment to this Act or other legislation or common law or any other matter relevant for operationalising the right to access information.

AWARENESS PROGRAMME

The RTI Act under Section 26 envisages that the Governments would develop and organize awareness programmes on the rights provided under the Act. It is also expected that Public Information Officers would be trained and relevant training materials produced for their use.

Under the Central Sector Scheme on "Improving Transparency and Accountability in government through effective implementation of Right to Information Act", West Bengal Information Commission has not received any fund during 2015 for organizing seminars and workshops and producing publicity materials on RTI.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Commission has made several recommendations in its Annual Reports. Many of these recommendations are still relevant but remain unimplemented. The Commission wishes to highlight the following issues while reiterating the earlier recommendations.

1. Strengthening of the Commission

The Commission sent a comprehensive proposal to Government in August, 2014 for reorganizing and strengthening the Commission's set up for its speedy and effective functioning vide No. 1612–WBIC/Admn–01/14 dated 22.08.2014 followed by a reminder vide No. 4219–WBIC/Admn–01/14 dated 19.08.2015. Attention of the Government is drawn for urgent implementation of the proposal. In this regard the Commission has issued reminder to the government in August, 2015 for urgent implementation of the proposal.

2. Reporting by Government Departments for the preparation of Commission's Annual Reports

The Commission is not getting reports from many Departments regularly for preparation of Annual Reports as envisaged in the RTI Act. In almost all cases where reports are received, they are incomplete and do not cover all the public authorities under the Department's jurisdiction. In fact, there is no clear information as to the number of public authorities under each Department and the number of State Public Information Officers appointed by them and their jurisdiction. In the absence of complete

reports from all Departments, the Commission's Annual Reports do not give the total picture regarding implementation of the RTI Act in the state.

3. Publicizing the list of State Public Information Officers and Appellate Authorities

The Commission reiterates its earlier recommendation in this regard and requests Government to publicize the particulars of the State Public Information Officer and Appellate Authority pertaining to each office of a public authority on the office notice boards for the benefit of the public.

In the absence of any such order, the Additional Superintendent of Excise & SPIO, Paschim Medinipur shall furnish the applicant a copy of the relevant file notings regarding the issue/renewal of the licence in question, except personal information furnished by the licensee, within 15 days.

Decision

Regional Transport Officer, Birbhum and former Regional Transport Officer, Birbhum appeared before the Commission in pursuance of its order dated 06.08.2015.

After hearing the submissions and on perusal of records it is seen that the Regional Transport Officer has furnished complete information to the applicant vide memo No. 1016/MV dated 06.08.2015 and Memo No. 1034/MV dated 10.08.2015. The Regional Transport Officer submits that he took over charge only on 23.06.2015 and the matter came to his notice only on 06.08.2015 when the hearing notice from the Commission was received. He further submits that after receiving the notice, he took all steps to furnish the information and that complete information has since been furnished.

Manirul Islam, former Regional Transport Officer, Birbhum who has since retired, submits that he held the position as additional charge from 31.03.2010 and to 24.12.2010 and during the period

he made all efforts to search out the records but failed. He further submits that since he was no longer looking after the work of RTO after that date, he was not in a position to do anything further in the matter. He tenders unconditional apology for his failure in furnishing the information while he was holding charge.

It appears that after 24.12.2010, the position of RTO was held by different officials and none of them also made adequate effort to furnish the information. It is seen that Vide Memo No. 144/MV dated 22.02.2011 the then Regional Transport Officer, Birbhum asked the applicant to deposit necessary government fees as per provision of MV Act Rules/GO for providing the information and the applicant paid Rs. 30/- by Demand Draft on 11.03.2011. In spite of that, the information has been furnished only in August 2015 after the notice was received from the Commission. Since different officials held the position of Regional Transport Officer at different periods of time since receipt of the RTI application, it is difficult to ascertain what steps were taken by each of them to provide information and to pin-point specific responsibility for the failure to furnish the requisite information.

After due consideration the Commission orders the public authority to compensate the applicant for the detriment suffered by him by paying a compensation of Rs.10,000/-(Ten thousand only). District Magistrate, Birbhum is directed to pay the amount of compensation of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand only) to the applicant Dilip Kumar Dutta within 30 days from the date of receipt of this order.

The 2nd appeal is thus disposed off.

Rules

1. Short title and commencement:-

- (1) These rules may be called the West Bengal Right to Information Rules, 2006.

2. Definitions:-

- (1) In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires, -
 - (a) "Act" means the Right to Information Act, 2005 (22 of 2005);
 - (b) "Commission" means the West Bengal Information Commission;
 - (c) "Registrar" means the Registrar of the Commission;
 - (d) "Section" means section of the Act;
 - (e) "State Government" means the Government of West Bengal.
- (2) Words and expressions used and not defined in these rules but defined in the Act, shall have the same meanings as respectively assigned to them in the Act.

3. Application fee :-

An application containing a request in writing to the State Public Information Officer or the State Assistant Public Information Officer, as the case may be, made under sub-section (I) of Section 6 for obtaining information, shall be accompanied with a court-fee of rupees ten.

4. 'Fee for providing information:-

Save as otherwise provided in the provision to sub-section (5) of Section '7, the State Public Information Officer or the State Assistant Public Information Officer, as the case may be, shall provide Information under sub-section (I), and sub-section (5), of Section 7 upon receipt or a request under Section 6, on payment of a fee of -

- (a) rupees two, for each page (in A-4 or A-3 size paper) created or copied; or
- (b) actual charge or cost price, for a copy in large size paper; or
- (c) actual cost price, for sample or model; or
- (d) rupees five for each fifteen minutes or fraction thereof, for inspection of records; or
- (e) rupees fifty per diskette or floppy, for information provided in the diskette or floppy;
- (f) actual charge fixed for publication or rupees two per page of photocopy for extracts there from for information provided in printed form.

5. Contents of appeal to Commission under sub-Section (3) of Section 19:-

An appeal to the Commission under sub-section (3) of Section 19, shall contain the following information, namely:-

- (a) Name and address of the applicant;
- (b) Name and address of the State Public Information Officer or the State Assistant Public Information Officer, as the case may be, who passed the order;
- (c) Particulars of the order against which the appeal is made including its number and date;

- (d) Brief facts of the case;
- (e) Prayer or relief sought for by the appellant;
- (f) Grounds for such prayer relief; and
- (g) Verification by the appellant

6. Documents to accompany appeal to Commission under sub-section (3) of Section 19:-

Every appeal made to the Commission shall be accompanied by the following documents, namely:-

- (a) the attested true copy of the order against which the appeal is being preferred;
- (b) the copies of the documents relied upon by the appellant and referred to in the appeal; and
- (c) an index of the documents referred to in the appeal.

7. Procedure in deciding appeal to Commission under sub-section (3) of Section 19:-

- (1) In deciding the appeal to the commission, the commission shall :-
 - (a) Hear, oral or written, evidence on oath or on affidavit from the concerned or interested person;
 - (b) Peruse or inspect documents, public records or copies thereof.
 - (c) Enquire through the authorized, officer for further details or facts;
 - (d) Hear the State Public Information Officer or the State Assistant Public Information Officer or such officer who decided the first appeal mentioned in sub-section (I) of Section 19, as the case may be;
 - (e) Hear the third party if required; and
 - (f) Receive evidence on 'affidavits' from State Public information Officer or the State Assistant Public Information Officer or such officer who decided the first appeal mentioned in sub-section (I) of Section 19 or from the third party; if any
- (2) In deciding the appeal the Commission may ask the appellant to add any other information other than the information included in the contents of the second appeal under rule 5.

8. Service of notice by Commission :-

The notice required to be issued under sub-section (9) of Section 19, by the Commission may be served in any of the following modes, namely:-

- (a) service by the party itself;
- (b) service by hand delivery through the process server;
- (c) service by the registered post with acknowledgement due
- (d) service through the head of office or the Department;

9. Signing of order:-

The order of the Commission pronounced in open proceedings shall be in writing and authenticated by the Registrar of any other officer authorized by the Commission in this behalf.

10. Terms and conditions of officers and other employees of Commission:-

The officers and other employees of the Commission shall be placed on deputation from the State Government on the usual terms and conditions

NOTIFICATION

No. 133-G-9th January, 2007-In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 28 (1) of the Right to Information Act 2005 the Chief Justice of the Calcutta High Court (Competent Authority) is pleased to make the following rules to carry out the provisions of the 'Act' falling within the jurisdiction of this High Court:-

Rules

1. Short title and commencement:-

- * These rules may be called The Calcutta High Court (Right to Information) Rules, 2006.
- * They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Definitions:-

1) In these Rules unless, the context otherwise requires,-

- * 'Act' means The Right to Information Act, 2005 (No. 22 of 2005);
- * 'Appellate Authority' means designated as such by the Chief Justice of High Court at Calcutta;
- * 'authorized person' means Public Information Officers and Assistant Public Information Officer;

'Public Information Officer' shall mean—(i) the Deputy Registrar (Admn.) on the Appellate Side of the High Court and (ii) the Assistant Master and Referee on the Original side of the High Court (iii) Chief Judicial Magistrate in the District Courts (iv) the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate in the respective sub-divisional courts.

Assistant Public Information Officer shall mean:-

- (i) in the Appellate Side of the High Court-
 - (a) Assistant Registrars of the respective departments
- (b) Section Officer or Superintendent whoever is in-charge of the concerned department/section, where there is no post of Assistant Registrar.
- (ii) in the Original Side of the High Court -
 - (a) Assistant Registrars of the respective departments
 - (b) Section Officer or Superintendent whoever is in-charge of the concerned department/section, where there is no post of Assistant Registrar.

- (iii) in the Sadar Sub-divisional courts the senior most Civil Judge (Jr. Div.).
 - 'Form' means the Forms appended to these Rules for enforcement of the provisions of this 'Section' means a section of this 'Act'
- (2) Word and expressions used but not defined in these Rules shall be the same meaning as assigned to them in respectively in the 'Act';

Request for obtaining information :-

A request for obtaining information may be made in writing or through electronic means in English, Hindi or Bengali accompanying a fee as prescribed below, by the person who desires to obtain the information to the Public Information Officer or the Assistant Public Information Officer, specifying the particulars of the information sought by him or her in the form prescribed below:-

In case the request cannot be made in writing the concerned Public Information Officer shall render reasonable assistance to that person to reproduce the same in writing.

All other provisions of section 6 of the Act shall apply in this respect.

4. Disposal of requests :-

For disposal of the requests under section 6 of the Act, the Public Information Officer or the Assistant Public Information Officer shall follow the provisions of section 7 of the 'Act'.

5 Protected/exempted information:-

The Public Information Officer or the Assistant Public Information Officer as the case may be have no obligation to give information to any citizen in the matter disclosure of which has been exempted under Section 8 of the Act.

6. Appeal:-

An appeal under section 19 of the "Act" may be preferred to the Appellate Authority, by the person who does not receive a decision within the time specified in section 7(3)(1)(a) of the Act or who is aggrieved by decision of the Public Information Officer or the Assistant Public Information Officer, as the case may be, in the time prescribed under section 19 (1) of the Act which may be extended as per provision or that section 19 (1) of the Act.

All other provisions of the Act shall apply for effective enforcement of the provisions relating to information as per Section 2(f) of the Act.

7. Penalties:-

- (1) whenever being bound to supply information fails to furnish the information asked for under Act within the time specified or fails to communicate the rejection order, shall be liable to a penalty up to fifty rupees per day for the delayed period beyond thirty days subject to maximum of five hundred rupees per application filed under rule 3 as may be determined by the Appellate Authority.
- (2) where the information supplied is found to be false in any material particular and which person is bound to supply it knows and has reason to believe it to be false or does not believe it to be true, the person supplying the information shall be liable to pay a penalty of a thousand rupees, to be imposed by the Appellate Authority, information provided that the Public Information Officer or the Assistant Public Information Officer, as the case may be shall be given reasonable opportunity of being heard before the penalty is imposed on him.

8. Suo motu publication of information by public authorities :-

- (1) the public authority shall suo motu publish information as per sub-section (1) of section under the Act by publishing booklets and/or folders and/or pamphlets and update these publication every year as required by sub-section (1) of Section 4 of the Act.
- (2) Such information shall also be made available to the public through information counter medium of internet and display on notice board at conspicuous places in the office of the authorized person are the Appellate Authority.

9. Fees:-

(1) The authorized person shall charge the fee at the following rates:-

A. Application Fee:-

(i) Information relating to tenders Five hundred rupees per application documents/bids quotation/business contract:

(ii) Information other than above Fifty rupees per application contract: Other Fees:

EXCLUSION FROM THE ACT

As per Section 24(4) of the RTI Act, the provisions of the Act will not apply to such intelligence and security organizations established by the State Government, as the State Government may, from time to time, by notification in the Official Gazette specify.

The following organizations have been exempted by the State Government vide notification No. 541–PAR(AR)/O/3M–29/2005 Pt. VILLA dated 29.08.2006 and notification No. 120–PAR(AR)/O/3M–29/2005 Pt. VIIIA dated 05.03.2009)
